The Congo Tree, is a registered organisation in the DR Congo. Established since 2013, our vision is to equip, inspire and support young people for peace and development in the community. Since 2013, we have mentored over 1500 young people in Eastern DR Congo and our work has reached over 20,000 people in Goma, Rutshuru and Masisi through our programmes.

# our programmes



## 1. WYLD :

Our leadership and mentoring programme for young people. We develop young people's skills by working on their personalities. Here, we create young leaders who can make a difference in the community by solving community problems. This is achieved through training, mentoring and social action.

## 2. Peace For the Future :

A programme that encourages young people to become peacemakers in their communities by promoting peaceful coexistence and a culture of peace. Based on the five pillars of R2250, we raise awareness among young people by talking to them about the United Nations' R2250, but we also advocate the involvement of young people in decision-making bodies.

### **3.Mwanzo Entreprise :**

A programme to help young people become entrepreneurs. We turn young people's ideas into businesses, enabling them to meet their basic needs. Since 2013, we have supported more than 100 social initiatives for young people and created more than 20 businesses, creating more than 780 stable jobs for young people.

### **4.Mwanzo Artistic :**

A programme that focuses on the talents of our young people. We organise artistic performances in the community (schools, camps for displaced persons, churches, etc.), showcasing young talent but also conveying messages of peace, peaceful coexistence, conflict resolution, resilience, and so on.
